Most of the denture-falling-out horror stories you've heard are because nothing is holding these dentures in place. With two to four simple implants placed in to the upper and lower jaw, the dentures can essentially go nowhere.

Dentures, themselves, are made of the safest materials available – typically comprised



of porcelain or acrylic materials. Compared to years past, the dentures of today are not as bulky, as well as look and feel more natural. The teeth can be 100 percent customized to your preference, including tooth size, shape, placement and color.

The implants holding them in, if maintained properly, can last a lifetime.

Our patients that have transitioned to implant supported dentures are able to eat better and have become healthier. They are more confident because they look and speak better. Their quality of life, appearance and smile are restored. And most importantly, they are no longer worried that their dentures will fall out in front of people.
